



RETHINK – “Reevaluate” How was I supposed to know?

Discussion

Discuss: The last time you ran across a situation that the Bible didn't directly talk about – how did you handle it?

[Tell them you will give them a scenario, and they need to determine what to do.]

Ask:

- Can you date a non-Christian?
- Can I attend parties?
- What movies can I watch?

Say: The key to answering these and other questions that arise, is not “Is there anything wrong with this” but “**Is this the wise thing to do**”.

Key Passage: (Eph. 5:15-16) read.

*“See then that you walk circumspectly (**live carefully**), not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is.”*

Ask:

- Why do you think we often push the limits with sin? Why is it so tempting to see how close to sin we can get without sinning?
- Is it enough to just say, “I won't ever do that”? What safeguards do we need?

Pray: for gift to get through life with – **WISDOM**.
